Correspondence received / Matters of Note

- Marconi/NSSA: PBe clarified that Marconi were suggesting shared *training* events rather than a shared NSSA team and everyone agreed this would be beneficial, allowing ASC sailors to gain some experience on open water and vice versa. He will continue the discussion with Mark Savill.
- Fire Service: FOS/RC met with the Fire Service and they would like to use the reservoir for practicing flood drills. FOS has discussed with the reservoir authorities and they have no objections. They are likely to require one day a week and there are in excess of 200 people to train. FOS highlighted the potential benefits to ASC: First Aid training; access to heavy lifting equipment and possibly a block membership fee.
- Although ASC has responded positively to the approach, there has been no movement re: Army membership previously discussed.

Financial Summary

- RB reported that the 2012 financial accounts are with the auditors. There was some discussion about the fact that the accounts are not 'audited' as such but are 'examined'. The assumptions about the definition of the word auditing have probably changed since the constitution was written and it was agreed it should reviewed in the light of this.
- RB reported that if the monies in the Barclays deposit account are moved to a Co-Operative account the interest rate would be doubled. The committee agreed to this course of action and authorized RB to change accounts. Prop: RC; Sec: JT
- It was further agreed that the new account would be set up so that transfers can only be made to other ASC bank accounts. On this basis it will be sufficient to have only two signatories (FOS and RB) and only one signature required to effect transfers.
- The exact amount to be held on deposit will be agreed by the committee via email once the account is opened.



Health and Safety

PBe expressed concern that the Rowers are on the water in extreme cold with no wetsuits, buoyancy aids or safety boat. The committee agreed that is not the responsibility of ASC to prescribe safety regulations for another sport and that per the constitution members use the reservoir at their own risk. That being said FOS/RC will raise the matter with the Rowers to make sure they fully understand the risks associated with their actions and furnish ASC with their current Safety Policy.

Safety incident 3rd Feb

- An incident was reported concerning an OK that capsized and was nearly lost. There was much discussion on the subject with the following outcomes:
 - A clause will be added to WA and to Winter Series entry for sailors to confirm that their buoyancy is up to date
 - o FOS suggested making a buoyancy measuring device available to members
 - o RC will post a message reminding members that it is their responsibility to maintain buoyancy
- During the discussion it became apparent that the root cause of the problem was that the boat was capsized too long as a result of the safety crew not being able to communicate with the helm who is deaf. This led to further discussion about developing a visual signal that can be used, at the OOD's discretion, to indicate to an individual that they are obliged to board the safety boat.
- It was also agreed that further consideration will be given to putting in place a process to allow the OOD to be aware of any competitors who have health issues or special needs.

Training:

RYA Supported Training

- Chris Hussey visited ASC on 16th Jan and met with representatives of the Committee. The outline Training Plan is to work towards ASC being a centre for powerboat training in the first instance and use this as a springboard to becoming a dinghy training centre.
